Pilgrimage Itinerary

Day 1: Sept. 27 ~ Atlanta

This evening we depart Atlanta for our transatlantic flight to Spain. During the flight enjoy dinner, movies, and breakfast before we arrive in Barcelona.

Day 2: Sept. 28 ~ Barcelona/Montserrat

Bienvenido a España! Welcome to Spain! This morning we arrive in Barcelona and meet our tour escort. We begin our pilgrimage with a tour of Barcelona including a visit to Sagrada Familia Basilica where Mass will be celebrated. Continue onto Montserrat and check into our Hotel Abat Cisneros for dinner and overnight.

Day 3: Sept. 29 ~ Montserrat/Lourdes

After breakfast, we'll take a cable car up the mountain to visit the dramatic Benedictine Monastery and the Shrine of Our Lady of Montserrat. Tradition says that St. Luke carved the statue of the Virgin around 50 A.D. Celebrate Mass followed by a lunch break before we continue to Lourdes. Dinner and overnight at the Grand Hotel Moderne in Lourdes.

Day 4: Sept. 30 ~ Lourdes

Enjoy breakfast before we begin the morning walking in the footsteps of St. Bernadette. We'll visit the Boly Mill where St. Bernadette was born, the "Cochot," where Bernadette lived with her family, the Chapel where she received her First Holy Communion, the Parish Church where St. Bernadette was baptized, and the famous Chapel at the Grotto where Our Lady appeared. Mass in one of the Lourdes chapels. Enjoy the afternoon free to explore the Shrine. This evening you can participate with fellow pilgrims from around the world in the Blessed Sacrament Procession and candlelight rosary procession. Dinner and overnight in Lourdes.

Day 5: Oct. 1 ~ Lourdes

Free day at leisure for personal devotions. Today you can submerge yourself in the healing baths, drink from the miraculous spring, walk the life size Stations of the Cross, pray in the Grotto, and spend time in the Adoration Chapel. Mass in one of the chapels. Tonight, have another opportunity to join in the candlelight rosary procession. Dinner and overnight in Lourdes.

Day 6: Oct. 2 ~ Lourdes/Loyola/Burgos

After breakfast, we depart for Loyola, birthplace of St. Ignatius, founder of the Jesuits. Visit the Basilica and the family home of St. Ignatius and celebrate Mass followed by lunch. We then continue to Burgos, the historic capital of Old Castile, and see the Old Quarter and the beautiful limestone Cathedral. Dinner and overnight at the Rice Reyes Catolicos Hotel in Burgos.

Day 7: Oct. 3 ~ Burgos/Leon/Santiago de Compostela

This morning we depart for Leon and visit the Old Quarter and the Basilica of San Isidoro where we'll celebrate Mass. After free time for lunch depart for Santiago de Compostela. Dinner and overnight at the San Francisco Hotel Monumento in Santiago de Compostela.

Day 8: Oct. 4 (Feast of St. Francis of Assisi) ~ Santiago de Compostela

After breakfast, we begin our day with a tour of the Old Quarter of the city followed by a visit to the magnificent Cathedral of St. James. We'll perform three of the rites that pilgrims make when visiting this famous Cathedral. First, we'll visit the crypt and venerate the relics of St. James. We'll have the opportunity to climb the stairs behind the altar where we can hug the statue of St. James. And finally celebrate Mass in one of the chapels. Before we leave we may have the opportunity to swing the Botafumeiro, the famous thurible that hangs by means of a system of pulleys from the main dome of the Cathedral. The afternoon free for lunch and personal devotions. This evening we'll visit a local restaurant for dinner. Overnight in Santiago de Compostela.

Day 9: Oct. 5 ~ Santiago de Compostela/Coimbra/Santarem/Fatima

We depart this morning for Coimbra and visit the Carmelite Monastery where Sr. Lucia, the oldest of the Fatima visionaries, lived as a Carmelite nun. We'll celebrate Mass and then a lunch stop before we visit Santarem, and the Church of St. Stephen with the oldest Eucharistic Miracle dating back to 1269. Continue onto Fatima for dinner and overnight in the Dom Gonzalo Hotel & Spa in Fatima.

Day 10: Oct. 6 ~ Fatima

Enjoy breakfast and then we begin our visit to Fatima. We'll visit the little Chapel of the Apparitions, the beautiful Basilica, the graves of Bl. Jacinta & Bl. Francisco, the Hamlet of Aljustrel where the three children lived, and Valinhos where Our Lady appeared after the children returned from prison. Mass this morning and the afternoon is free for personal devotions with time to explore Fatima. This evening join in and experience the famous candlelight procession. Dinner and overnight in Fatima.

Day 11: Oct. 7 ~ Fatima/Alba de Tormes/Avila (Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary)

After breakfast, we depart for Alba de Tormes and celebrate Mass at the Carmelite Monastery, where St. Teresa of Avila died in 1582 and is buried. In the museum, we will see the incorrupt heart and arm of St. Teresa of Avila. Enjoy a lunch break before we continue to Avila for dinner and overnight at the Palacio de Los Velada Hotel.

Day 12: Oct 8 ~ Avila/Toledo

This morning after breakfast we'll celebrate Mass at the Incarnation Monastery where St. Teresa became a nun. Afterwards we'll have the chance to visit the large museum dedicated to her life. Then we'll visit beautiful Avila surrounded by the 11th century walls and walk in the footsteps of the first woman Doctor of the Church, St. Teresa of Avila. We'll visit La Santa Monastery, built on the sight of the house where the saint was born, and visit St. Joseph Monastery, the first Monastery founded by St. Teresa. We then depart for Toledo and take a tour of this beautiful city and the Cathedral. Dinner and overnight at Hotel San Juan de Los Reyes in Avila.

Day 13: Oct. 9 ~ Toledo/Madrid/USA

Enjoy our final breakfast in Spain before we depart for the airport in Madrid for our flight back to the USA. We say a fond farewell to our pilgrim family.

Tour Conditions

Reservations and Payments: Reservation deposit is due by April 5, 2017 and final payment is due July 10. Invoice will be sent for final payment. If booking is made after July 10, full payment is required. Payments must be made by check or money order. Credit cards are not accepted. Returned checks will incur a \$35 service fee. Name must appear on reservation form exactly as it appears on the passport. Visitation Pilgrimages & Tours is not responsible for airline tickets penalties or other costs that may result from the incorrect name supplied on the registration form.

Passport: A valid USA Passport is required and must be valid until April 10, 2018, which is the required 6 months after the return date. Citizens of the USA do not require a visa. A copy of your passport is required along with the registration form.

Final Documents: Final documents are issued approximately 3-4 weeks prior to departure and only upon receipt of final payment. It is the responsibility of each passenger to check their e-ticket for correct flights and spelling of name. In case of an error, notify Visitation Pilgrimages & Tours immediately.

Price: The traveler is responsible for any increase in hotel and/or airline taxes, government fees, fuel surcharge, costs due to fluctuation in the Euro exchange rate, or fewer number of pilgrims than required. Any increase will be reflected in the final invoice. If you request to join the group and purchase the airline ticket yourself, the Land Only cost: \$3,125 per person/double occupancy. However, if your international flight arrives or departs later than the group flight, you will be responsible at your own cost to provide transportation to the hotel or airport. The group will not wait for your flight to arrive or depart earlier for your return flight. If the pilgrimage is cancelled for any reason the domestic or internationally airfare purchased outside of Visitation Pilgrimages & Tours is your sole responsibility.

Cancellations and Refunds: All cancellations must be in writing. Cancellations will incur a minimum of \$600 per person fee in addition to any airline and hotel expenses and/or penalties incurred by Visitation Pilgrimages & Tours. No refunds 40 days prior to departure or no show. Airline tickets are non-refundable after ticketing. Due to the non-refundable clause issued by the hotels due to the 100th Anniversary of Fatima, a minimum of \$600 will not be refunded for any reason including the event that the group will not go for any unforeseen reason such as, but not limited to, lack of participating pilgrims or terrorist activities. Travelers are strongly advised to purchase travel insurance.

Participation: Visitation Pilgrimages & Tours reserves the right to refuse to accept or retain any person whose behavior is deemed likely to affect the smooth operations of a tour, or adversely affect the enjoyment or safety of passengers. Visitation Pilgrimages & Tours is under no liability to any such person for refund, compensations, repatriation or any other matters arising.

Medical Conditions: Visitation Pilgrimages and Tours does not guarantee special facilities or assistance for disabled passengers. Disabled passengers must provide their own physically able companion for assistance. Visitation Pilgrimages & Tours is not responsible for any medical conditions that may occur prior, during, or after the pilgrimage.

Air Transportation: All air transportation is in economy class on IATA approved carriers. Fares and schedules are subject to change without notice. If you would like to secure a specific airline set, we will make every effort to accommodate you however, we cannot guarantee seating assignments since they are at the sole discretion of the airline. Visitation Pilgrimages & Tours is not responsible for any cancellations, loss, delays, injury, illness, or expenses incurred due to actions made by the airlines. Travelers are strongly advised to purchase travel insurance. Add on air is available from your home city and price quote is available upon request. You may purchase your own domestic air however, you will need to make sure that you are in Atlanta at least 2 1/2 hours prior to the international flight. If you miss the international flight you will need to work with the airline to rebook your flight which may result in an additional charge which is your responsibility. Once in Spain you will need to arrange your own transportation to meet the group. Any domestic or international airline ticket purchased on your own is your sole responsibility even if the group cancels for any reason.

Hotel Accommodations: Hotel accommodations are based on double occupancy. Triple accommodations may be available. A limited number of single rooms are available at the supplement price. Visitation Pilgrimages & Tours reserves the right to change hotels for any unforeseen reason. If you require a roommate, Visitation Pilgrimages & Tours will make every effort to find another pilgrim in need of a roommate. If no one can be found, you will be required to pay the single supplement.

Meals: Breakfast and dinner daily as per itinerary. Lunches are not included. There is no refund for unused meals.

Baggage: If traveling to or from USA: There is no charge for 1 piece of checked luggage 50 lbs. max with max dimensions of 62 inches. Carry-on items include 1 personal item and 1 piece of luggage with max dimensions of 45 inches. Passengers are responsible for any additional fees airlines may impose on baggage. Please check with airline for updated rules and regulations since they do periodically change. Luggage handling at hotels is limited to 1 bag per person. If group arrives late in the evening or departs early in the morning from hotels, portage may not be available. Passengers would then be responsible to handle their own luggage.
