We had a wonderful meeting this Saturday and look forward to seeing you all at our next meeting on September 10th.

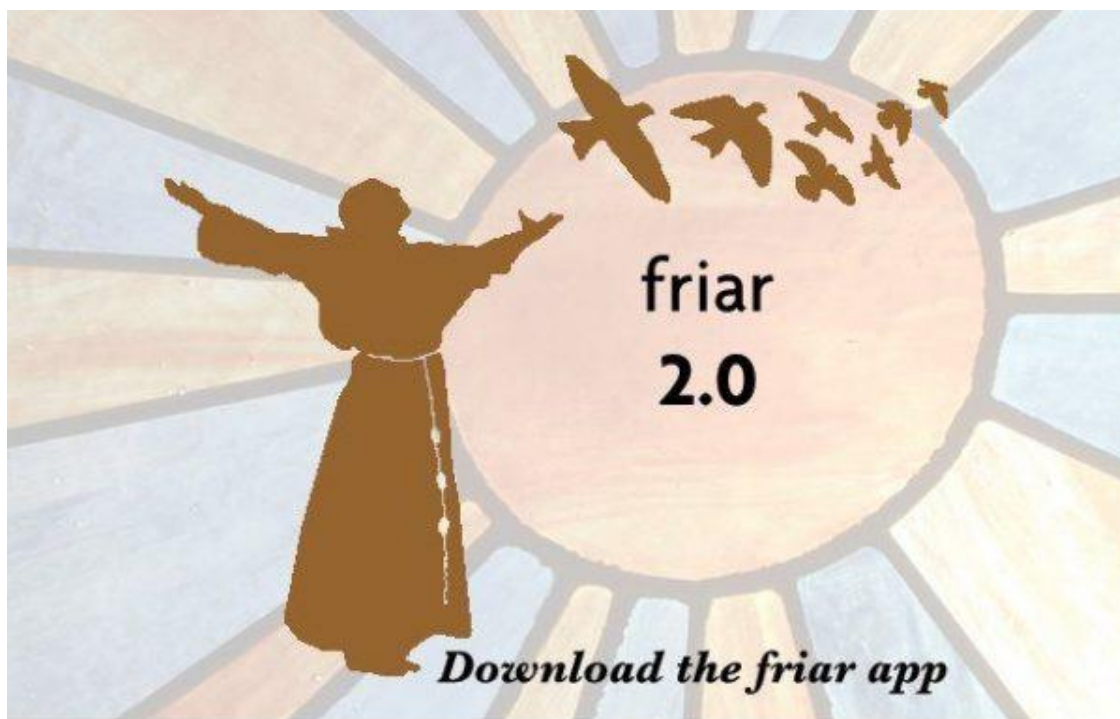
