

SPIRTUAL ASSISTANT'S CORNER


Our 22nd article to the Rule tells us:

Annually, we have to do a new sign up sheet for the next 12 months of dinners for the Dorothy Day Shelter. Our Delivery Schedule begins in November of the current year. For many years now we have supplied a very wonderful monthly meal to the Shelter which is located down the street from the White Flint Metro at 5320 Marinelli RD Rockville MD 20852. Marilyn frequently stays and visits with the residents and sometimes other Fraternity members join her. Items are dropped off any time before 5 PM, even several days in advance.

Please sign up at our meeting for monthly duty, bi-monthly duty or quarterly duty. Many hands make light work. May God bless us with generous and kind hearts as we look at the blank schedule. I have purposely left ALL the spaces BLANK since we have new people who might find inspired to help. I will circulate the sign up—sheet TWO TIMES around the room in the hopes of getting all the boxes filled in.

This is a very important apostolate of our Fraternity. Frankly we are often inconvenienced and stressed by it, the food costs money and the preparation and delivery take time and planning. YES IT IS OUR VERY OWN FRATERNITY CROSS THAT WE CARRY TOGETHER! We are SO BLESED to carry this small cross for our fellow neighbors for love of them and for love of God and, yes, for holy self-love as it blesses us so mightily in time and in eternity.

Each month the Shelter mails me a calendar showing for each day the particular name of the dinner providers such as "Secular Franciscan Group" (yes, that is us!) and every month I am saddened to see that so many days have no providers. For example in July, 13 of the 31 days had no dinner providers. That is over a third of the time no dinners were delivered! This is a wonderful opportunity to serve our Lord in our disadvantaged neighbor. Yes, these opportunities are HEAVENLY GOLD to us and THE RESIDENTS are JESUS to us. Jesus said so! Let us keep up the good work!
