Greetings from Brother Lawrence, OFM Conv.

We are deep into the Lenten season and the Sacred Triduum falls at the very end of March. I certainly hope that your Lent is what you have expected it to be this year. Sometimes we fall in our Lenten season at times and sometimes Lent goes just the way we were expecting it to go. Other years it is inconsistent, but when this happens we still need to keep the Lenten season as we wanted it to be!

The season is a most important one for our preparation for the Triduum and for Easter itself. We have difficulty at times in our Lenten journey but we need to do the best we can for the preparation for Triduum and Easter is most important. It is important to think towards the end of Lent because it helps to prepare us for the most important time of the Church year. It must be a restart each and every time we fall in our attention to Lent and what are doing in order to make ourselves ready for the Sacred Triduum and Easter. Therefore, we must respond to any fall by intentionally getting back into your Lenten practices.

When we get to the final days and we begin to commemorate and consider the final days of Jesus' ministry it is most important to be able to make the most of our recalling of Jesus' final days and his sacrifice for us and as long as we continue to avoid losing ourself in a falling from the practices of Lent we should be able to get back to our practices that will surely continue to help us prepare for the Triduum and Easter.
